636. District Council Matters

Government Minister Savid Jaheed is minded to agree to the merger of West Somerset and Taunton Deane to form a new Council.

There is some doubt about the Police now moving into the Council Offices.

Hinkley Point workforce is increasing with c.2500 on site.

Business rates on Hinkley B revalued so shortfall is less than expected.

West Somerset Lottery had made about £46,000 so far.

637. County Council Matters

Somerset University will take several years to establish.

Library Consultation is going on; Williton is not affected.

Budget has been increased 3.9%. Social Care getting another 1% from Government.

Childrens Services improved but still underperforming.

4 Aldermen appointed.

638. Financial Matters

639. Open Forum

A member of the Parish read out a letter he had written to the Parish Council about dog fouling and asked if anything could be done. The Clerk will find out the cost of another bin. It was agreed to deliver a flier to all houses in the Parish asking dog owners to clean up after their dogs and to have some posters laminated. Councillors recognise that some of the fouling is caused by dog owners who live outside the village.
